Creation of raised rear patio, installation of PV Panels and fenestration alterations to all elevations including the removal, replacement and installation of windows and doors. Expansion of existing hardstanding and installation of EV charging point.) To allow for the use of Natureclad wood effect cladding on the new gable ends and front dormers and elevational alterations to include the removal of 4no windows and 2no. sets of doors to the rear to be made into 1no. set of 4m sliding doors
- d) **26/P/0464/OUT Land At Poplar Farm West End Lane Nailsea** Outline application for the development of up to 130 dwellings (Class C3) with associated landscaping, access and infrastructure. Details of the principal vehicle access from Leighwood Drive provided in detail, with matters of appearance, landscaping, layout and scale are reserved for subsequent approval.
