Good afternoon,

At the Wraxall & Failand Parish Council meeting held on 14th March the Councillors were told by NSC Councillor Ash Cartman that the CCTV system at Nailsea and Backwell Train Station was broken beyond repair. He said that the cost of a replacement system would be in the region of £35,000. NSC does not have the funds to purchase a new CCTV system, so the likelihood is that it will remain inoperative for the foreseeable future. The Wraxall & Failand Councillors are concerned that people using the train station are parking their cars and leaving bicycles under the false impression that these are 'being watched' by CCTV which is not the case. It is believed that a number of bike thefts have recently taken place at the station.

I have been asked to contact Nailsea Town Council, Backwell Parish Council and Flax Bourton Parish Council to see if you would send a representative to a joint meeting, at a time and venue to be arranged, where ideas could be shared with the possible aim of jointly finding funding for a new CCTV system. Can I ask that you include this on the agenda for your next Parish Council meeting and let me know what your thoughts are on this matter.
